4. Speed / Congestion / Parking

The Committee had been copied into a resident's email to CC M James requesting that speed restrictions be applied from St Dogmaels to Poppit. It was noted that CC M James was already in consultation with Highways officers and Police on the proposal.

Concern was expressed that the speed sign between Cardigan and St Dogmaels only lit up when traffic exceeded 36/38 mph.

5. Footpaths

Eagle St Footpath – from Cardigan Town

St Dogmaels Footpaths Group would look at registration process as part of a winter project. The group was thanked for its time.
