St. Dogmaels Community Council is aware of the importance of operating an Environmental Policy, in order to reduce and keep to the minimum the impact that its activities have upon the environment.

St. Dogmaels Community Council will endeavour to operate in a manner, which minimises energy consumption, the use of material resources and the creation of waste and pollution. Wherever it is practically possible, St. Dogmaels Community Council will confine its consumption to renewable or sustainable resources.

St. Dogmaels Community Council will:

Review its activities and operations on an annual basis to identify environmental aspects and prioritise actions to address them.

Seek to continually reduce energy and resources consumption.

Minimise the amount of waste that it generates and adopt the principles of reduce, re-use, repair and recycle.

Minimise the use of toxic material and prevent pollution.

Generate an awareness of sustainable issues amongst its staff, Councillors and the Community.

Ensure as far as possible that all goods and services procured conform to its environmental policy.

Meet all relevant UK, European and International legislative and regulatory requirements and agreements.

Consult with and seek advice from relevant expert environmental and sustainable authorities as required.

Endeavour to follow the best accepted practice in relation to all environmental and sustainable matters.
