THIS WILL SEE THE CLUB RUNNING 6 TEAMS IN TOTAL, U6, U8, U10, U12, U14, U16 WITH PLAYERS DRAWN FROM THE VILLAGE AND SURROUNDING AREAS. THIS APPLICATION IS TO SUPPORT THE COACH DEVELOPMENT AND NEW EQUIPMENT COSTS TO SUPPORT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS NEW TEAM. PLEASE SEE BREAKDOWN ATTACHED.
