In today's edition of the Tivyside Advertiser (03/08/2021) the Council will be advertising its intention to introduce a 40mph speed limit on the following roads:

- B4546 from St Dogmaels to Poppit Sands,
- C3109 from the junction with the B4546 south for 55m
- U3218 entire length from the

Full details of which are attached within the PDF document and available on the Pembrokeshire.gov.uk website.

The proposals are being promoted following representation/petition from the local community and supported by Elected Member. The B4546 forms part of National coastal path of Wales and Pembrokeshire Coastal Path as such attracts a substantial number of visitors on foot and pedal cycle. The route is a single carriageway with localised narrow sections over its length. Recent speed monitoring recorded mean average speeds of below 40mph and therefore the proposed 40mph is considered appropriate for this section of road and the environment.
