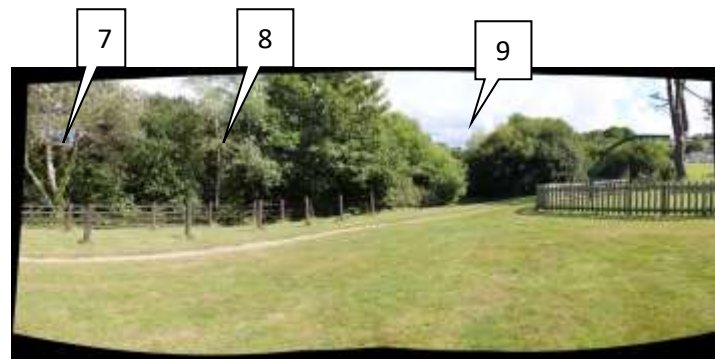
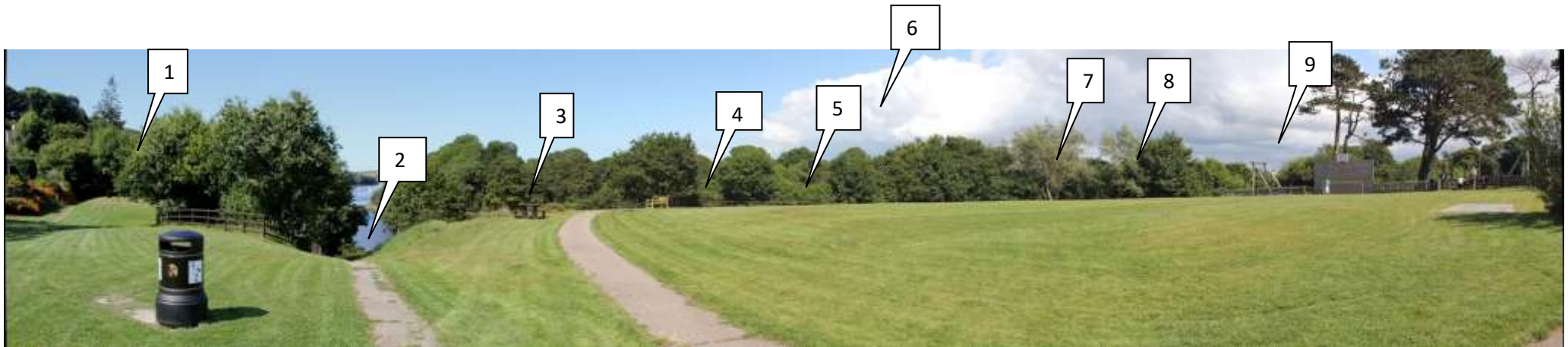


Alexandra Gardens, St Dogmaels - Site visit on 3rd June 2015
10 year Maintenance agreed with NRW Sept 2015





1 – remove 'garden' species, Box Leaved Honeysuckle (*Lonicera nitida*) and Pheasant Berry (*Leycesteria Formosa*) and any small ash



2 - Blessing stone area: Cut hedging along bank to shoulder height along length of path. View from beach below (left). Example of height on path (below) Leave oak. No arisings to be left on site as nothing should enter the river.



3 – trim back to fence height to preserve view.



4 – trim back to between first and second rail height to preserve view



5 - Trim to between first and second rail height preserving young oak



6 – thin along fence line (and a little further back) to open up



7. Take out overhanging branch by stannels

8. Monitor white poplar (ongoing)



9 - Cut back to between first and second rail height preserving two young oaks either side which should, eventually, frame the view to Cardigan
