However, it will also support ongoing revenue costs if an organisation can demonstrate its lack of funds and the adverse effect on St Dogmaels and its residents if the organisation is unable to continue or is hampered by lack of funds.

Wales Air Ambulance is the official air ambulance service for Wales. We are on standby 24/7, 365 days a year because we believe everyone in Wales deserves fast, critical care whenever and wherever they may be.

Our service is often described as a flying emergency department. The on-board consultants and critical care practitioners are highly skilled and carry some of the most pioneering medical equipment in the world. They can deliver blood transfusions, administer anaesthesia and undertake emergency operations at the scene of the incident, before flying the patient to specialist care. In 2020 we attended 3414 incidents, 77 of which were in the Pembrokeshire region.

In order to keep our 4 helicopters flying and providing this lifesaving service, we need to raise £8m annually. Our fundraising income has been severely impacted by the pandemic and is still struggling to recover. We have been unable to attend fundraising events, our shops were closed during the lockdowns and we were unable to canvass face to face for people to join our in-house lottery.

Any donation the community council can make will be very much appreciated.
