However, it will also support ongoing revenue costs if an organisation can demonstrate its lack of funds and the adverse effect on St Dogmaels and its residents if the organisation is unable to continue or is hampered by lack of funds.

Applications will only be accepted from charitable and non-profit making organisations. The council regrets that applications from commercial organisations or individuals will not be considered.

A New Year's party for families, offering a one-day event, plus two sessions. This will provide two staff, refreshments, play facilities and support. The cost will include hall-hire fees, staff and refreshments for those attending. Although Jig-So does provide facilities and support to at least ten families in the St. Dogmaels area, this extra event will be open to all families and children.

At present, Jig-So operates weekly sessions to existing St. Dogmaels residents (as previously stated) which is funded by Pembrokeshire County Council, the proposed event is hoped to be funded by St. Dogmaels Community Council and Jig-So, since existing funding are stretched.
